## **GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES:**

The Abuse Investigator assumes primary responsibility for investigation and assessment of reported incidents of child abuse in accordance with the Child and Family Services Act and the Provincial Standards on abuse.

## **SPECIFIC DUTIES:**

- Case Management of child abuse cases.
- Responds to all intakes/ referrals/ reports indicating child abuse.
- Presents information in either family or criminal court proceedings as required.
- In accordance with the Provincial policy, cases refer to the Child Abuse Committee for their review and recommendations.
- Maintains statistical records consistent with the agency and provincial requirements.
- Consults Supervisor to determine and decide the most appropriate and effective means of investigations.
- The child abuse investigator prepares all information for court process.
- Liaison with Child Abuse Committee
- Referrals to other resources as needed.

## **QUALIFICATIONS/ REQUIREMENTS:**

- Minimum Post Secondary education in social services and/or minimum 3 years relevant work experience in Child Protection.
- Good interviewing and assessment skills.
- Working knowledge of Child Abuse investigations.
- Excellent communication, leadership and organizational skills.
- Experience in counseling children and families.
- Good working knowledge of Provincial Legislation and Standards.
- Ability to work as a team member.
- Must have good computer skills and knowledge of Child & Family Services Information System (CFSIS).
