GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

Under the direct supervision of the Urban Program Manager, the Supervisor will be part of the Management Team.

SPECIFIC DUTIES:

- Ensures that the agency is adhering to all Provincial Child Welfare Regulations and Standards.
- Demonstrated ability to supervise staff with caseloads requiring experience in Intake, Child Protection and Family Service.
- Excellent assessment skills and knowledge of separation and attachment issues.
- Conducting regular case reviews with workers and ensuring documentation is up to date.

QUALIFICATIONS/REQUIREMENTS:

- Degree or Diploma in Social Services and/or equivalent combination of related education and work experience related to Child Welfare.
- A minimum of five (5) years' experience in child welfare.
- A minimum of one (1) year supervisory experience.
- Knowledgeable Child Protection Court procedures.
- Ability to speak First Nations Language will be considered an asset.
- Must possess a valid driver's license and access to your own vehicle; some travel will be required.
